PBIS NEWS

Pleasant Garden Elementary was recognized by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction for our implementation of Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS). PBIS focuses on using best evidence-based behavioral and academic practices for improving important academic and behavior outcomes for all students.

PGE was named a Green Ribbon school, which awards schools that have successfully designed and implemented systems and practices that support appropriate behavior in all students. To earn Green Ribbon status, our school had to have the following things in place: completion of universal training, active administrative involvement, a PBIS team that meets monthly, an identified in-school coach or team coordinator, a score of at least 80% on the School Evaluation Tool, and a score of at least 80% on the Universal section of the Implementation Inventory. PGE scored a perfect 100% on the School Evaluation Tool and the Implementation Inventory.

PGE was given a banner for this prestigious recognition. It is in the front hall next to the PBIS bulletin board. Take a second to look at it the next time you are visiting our school. We have PG Pride!
